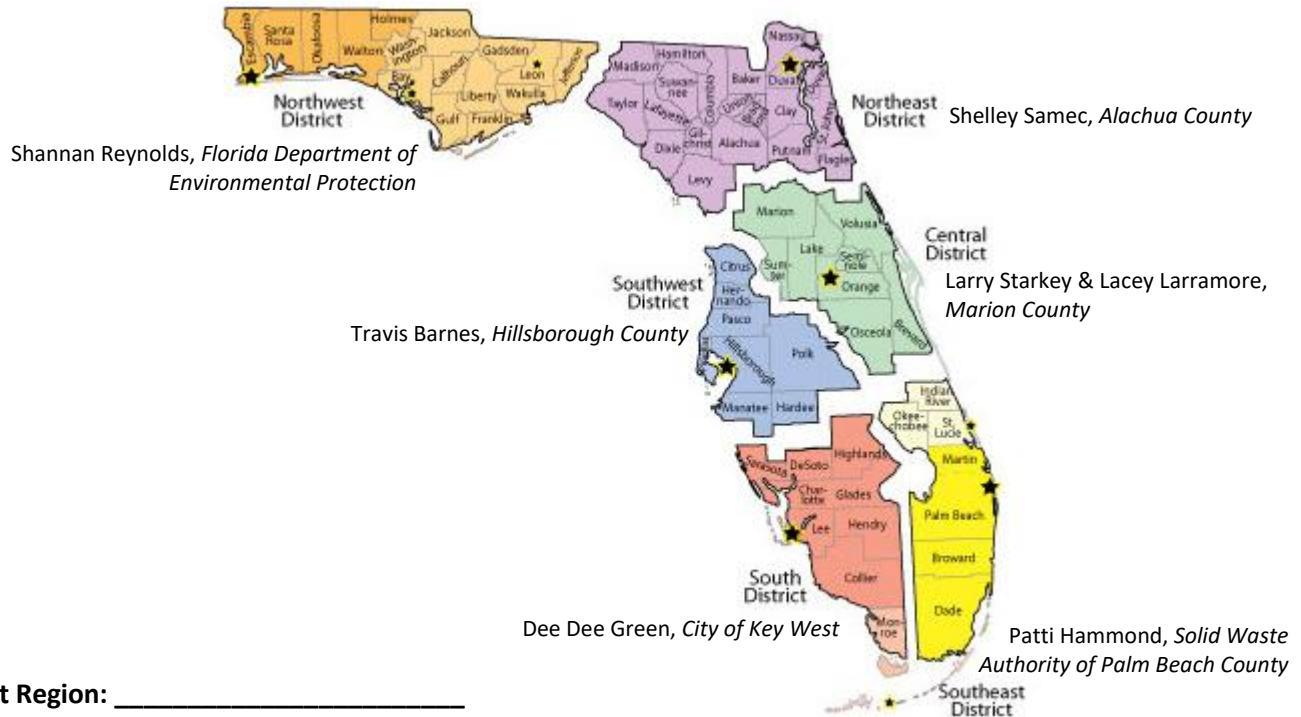


General Track 2- Getting to Know Your Neighbors (Interactive Session)
