This rubric is used in scoring submissions for the Recycle Florida Today Environmental Sustainability Award. The Recycle Florida Today Environmental Sustainability Award (R.F.T.E.S.) is the industry's premier recognition of those having outstanding programs or events centered on recycling and environmental sustainability. Emphasis is placed on annually honoring an individual or organization that are pursuing significantly increased awareness which motivates recycling, composting, waste reduction and other sustainability efforts. The award winner will display exemplary practices in their respective organizations.

The award recognizes those in the field of recycling who have made a sustained and significant contribution to the field through their work. It is not restricted with respect to the level of work or the type of work that individuals may undertake during their professional lives but seeks to recognize individuals who are making notable contributions to the field of recycling.

Submissions are reviewed and voted on by a committee of industry peers using the rubric below.
