Rebranding, Sustainability and Trilingual Campaign

Collier County's Waste Reduction and Recycling team experienced the issue of reaching different demographics and producing material that is relevant and appealing for residents. Recycling is an important factor in environmental stewardship, requiring active participation from customers. Residents of Collier County include older, affluent retirees as well as immigrants whose first language is Spanish and Haitian Creole. Collier County developed a rebranding, sustainability and trilingual campaign that encouraged residents to recycle right while emphasizing the messaging of preserving our paradise and our environment. As Collier County is a popular tourist destination and known for its beaches, The Everglades and other natural resources, it was essential that the team create a message that incorporates this theme and resonate with its residents. The team came up with, "Help Preserve our Paradise." Collier County has implemented a creative and unique approach to tackle contamination and barriers that public entities face. It has been a successful campaign that has allowed Collier County to build a better relationship with its residents and the public. The campaign consisted of rebranding of its educational and promotional material, promoting sustainability and including educational material in three languages, English, Spanish and Haitian Creole.

The campaign consisted of the following:

- Incorporating more photo focused messaging. Less wording would allow residents and the public to quickly glance over material and understand messaging.
- Materials were printed in the three most used languages in Collier County: English, Spanish and Creole to overcome any language barriers among our target audiences. To ensure that language would not hinder understanding of the messages, we also used photos of recyclable items.
- Implementing visually and aesthetically pleasing material. Promotional and educational material were rebranded to incorporate colors that represented the area.
- Promoting sustainable material and swag. Another major goal is to divert items that go to the landfill. We choose items that incorporate the message of reusing. We ordered reusable water bottles, reusable grocery store bags, reusable utensils, sandwich bags and reusable bento boxes for lunch. Collier County decided to only promote sustainable material instead of trendy items or easily disposable.
- Rebranding educational material to have a tagline. "Preserve our Paradise." Instead of promoting our county, we are promoting our messaging. The public does not know what Solid and Hazardous Waste Management means. That is why we produced a tagline that allows residents to put a meaning behind the action of recycling. As our goal is to change a behavior, we decided to implement a message that would resonate with residents who live in Collier County.

The following presentation will display a before and after of material used to highlight Collier County's Recycling Program, including a new trilingual magnet, a new cart sticker, new videos on recycling and our recycling centers, and the addition of our new promotional material and swag.
