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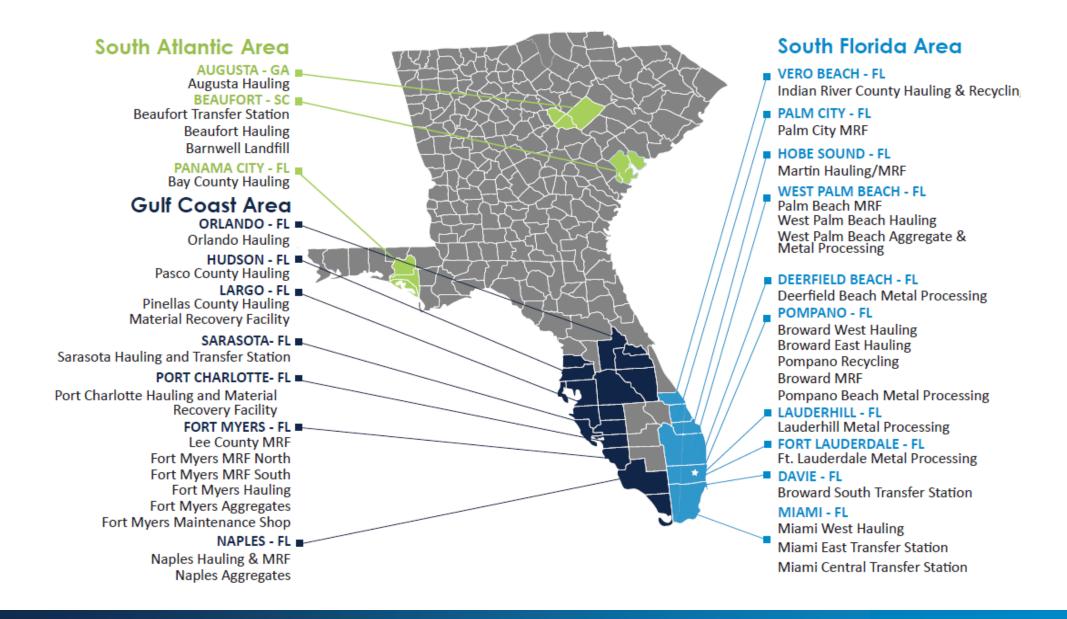

Recycling Efforts and Waste Diversion Programs

At Coastal Waste, we currently operate ten (10) Construction and Demolition (C&D) Material Recovery Facilities, a Metal Processing Facility and two (2)

From our beginning in 2017 with one operation in Hobe Sound, we have increased our overall operations from one location to forty-two, employing over 1600 people. The materials we recycle are recognized nationally as the largest components of the waste stream. In the State of Florida it is number one with over 35% of the total waste generated by our citizens. In addition to creating jobs, it provides for a greater degree of environmental protection, a smarter use of natural resources, a net decrease in greenhouse gas emissions and vast energy savings. The recycling of this material keeps it out of landfills and returns valuable commodities, such as wood, metals, plastics, and concrete, back into the economy in a highly valuable reusable product. With innovative practices, state-of-the-art systems, and highly skilled individuals, Coastal processed over 1.1 million tons of material in 2024 at approximately 65% recycling rate.

Sustainability Programs

In Early 2024, we unveiled our first electric truck and excitedly added it to the fleet. Coastal Waste was the first private company in the state of Florida to make this significant investment in electric equipment showing our commitment to not only revolutionizing our operations but also setting a new standard for innovation in our industry.

Among the highlights of our electrified fleet are the Mack LR Electric Class 8 refuse truck and the Volvo EC230 Electric Excavator. These state-of-the-art vehicles represent our commitment to reducing our carbon footprint while maintaining the high standards of performance and efficiency that our customers expect from us. We're particularly excited about our continued partnership with Volvo Construction Equipment and Mack Trucks, whose dedication to sustainability aligns perfectly with our own values.

Recycling Education

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With a focus on Recycling Education, we provide a variety of programs throughout Florida with an emphasis on intergenerational programming. From elementary school recycling education, through touch-a-truck programs, high school scholarship programs, to adult community recycling presentations, we believe providing education and resources to the generators of the waste are the key to success in higher recycling percentages.

In the first 4 months of 2025 we have already done well over 10 events as a company, reaching approximately 1,000 children and families. We see each event as a chance to make an impression and teach proper recycling practices. By educating the youth, and their families, we are able to instill an emotional connection and sense of personal responsibility. We believe when our community is able to connect with us in person it encourages them to do their part in the community and RECYCLE!







Although we have many programs currently in place, we don't plan on stopping there. This summer we are launching our very first Coastal Cares: Coastal Clean-Up. We are planning a beach clean-up in each area we serve. We believe it is important as a company to give back and set an example, with our very own employees donating their time to give back to the communities we serve each day.

Inspiring the Youth in our Communities: Cal's Story

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Our team is passionate about what they do. But they are even more passionate to make a real difference. Below are two stories of how Coastal team members took it upon themselves to directly impact two young boys in our communities. Both stories come from different facilities, hundreds of miles away from each other, but both proving that our core values are deeply rooted in how we serve and our commitment to make a difference.

"My name is Chris Lowder and we are Coastal Waste & Recycling residential customers We have an eleven year old son, Cal, who absolutely loves the waste and recycling industry. He waits outside for the Coastal truck to come by and empty the waste and recycling bins. One morning a Coastal truck came by and the driver spoke to Cal while making his route rounds. Cal told me about the conversation and asked if Coastal sold any merchandise, shirts. hats, trucks etc. I called the local Coastal number and spoke with customer service employee, Tatianna. Tatianna was very helpful and courteous. She offered to send Cal a gift bag with Coastal collectibles."

"Later that afternoon, I received a call from Mr. Gavin Bush, the Coastal local route supervisor. Mr. Bush advised that he was going to gather some Coastal items for Cal and come by our house and deliver the items.

Mr. Bush and members of the Coastal Team came by our house with a gift bag for Cal, including a replica truck, Coastal Hat, Coastal scarf, small waste bins, and hand sanitizer. Mr. Bush explained the process of waste pick up to Cal and how the truck operates. Cal was fascinated and loved Mr. Bush and the team taking their time to explain their jobs.

Cal is in fifth grade and has his own business, called Cal Carts. We have curbside waste and recycling pickup in our neighborhood. One section of our neighborhood is elderly residents. Cal services eleven homes in this area weekly by taking their waste and recycling bins from their garage."
